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## Coordinator Responsibilities

- Work closely with the county 4-H Youth Extension Educator.
- Coordinate the county 4-H Shooting Sports program.
- List all activities on the county *4-H Unit Activity Report Form*.
- Assist the 4-H Educator in keeping proper documentation (firearm inventory, range plans, certified instructor list, member list).
- Submit an annual financial report and have the finances audited every five years (and whenever there is a new treasurer).
- Complete the annual IRS filing requirements by May 15.

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## 4-H Shooting Sports Objectives

- To promote the highest standards of safety, sportsmanship, and ethical behavior, including sound decision making.
- To enhance development of self-concept, character, and personal growth through socially acceptable involvement in shooting activities.
- To teach safe and responsible use of firearms and archery equipment, self-discipline, and concentration.

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## Policy Statement: program requirements

**Volunteer instructors must:**

- **County** – Complete the Indiana 4-H Youth Development application/screening process and annual re-enrollment via 4HOnline; 4-H Educator will place volunteers in approved roles
- **State** – Complete the State 4-H Shooting Sports Certification Workshop

**All Indiana 4-H Shooting Sports Programs must have a 4-H Shooting Sports Certified Coordinator**

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## Policy Statement: program requirements

**Prohibited activities:**

- Arranging or conducting hunting activities with (or for) 4-H members
- Tree climbing or activities involving tree stands (instruction about this topic may be led by Outdoor Skills instructors)
- Reloading of firearms cartridges and shells
  - Cartridges and shells should be purchased from authorized manufacturers who apply industry standards in the manufacturing and loading process

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## Policy Statement: program requirements

**Indiana 4-H Shooting Sports Certified Instructors**

- Directly supervise activities for which they hold certification
- Responsible for teaching in only the discipline in which they are certified

**Associate Instructors**

- May assist a certified instructor on the range
- Any individual who works with the 4-H program should complete the volunteer screening process

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## Position Statement

Why does 4-H offer a shooting sports program?

- Teaches self-confidence, personal discipline, responsibility, teamwork, and sportsmanship
- Appeals to youth that may not be interested in other 4-H offerings
- Teaches safe and ethical use of firearms

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## 4-H Shooting Sports Meetings

- Purpose: share information, provide youth leadership opportunities, allow youth to shoot.
- Required meetings are rare in 4-H. However, one safety meeting *may* be required in 4-H Shooting Sports.
- **If** your county requires a 4-H SS safety meeting:
  - Safety meeting agenda must be approved, followed, and on file with Coordinator and 4-H Educator
  - Offer multiple dates and/or delivery options whenever possible
- Safety guidelines are to be reviewed at ALL range meetings

**Note: Hunter Education (IDNR) may be recommended, but may not be required**

Sending potential Shooting Sports volunteers to certification workshops	Submitting required compliance statement and range plans to the State 4-H Office	Requests for Certificate of Insurance (RM 02)

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## 4-H Volunteers

**\*\* Volunteers are the core of the county 4-H program \*\***

- All 4-H programs depend on the dedication, time, and involvement of volunteers
- 4-H Volunteers include: 4-H program and project volunteers and members of county Extension boards, county 4-H councils, county 4-H fair boards, and numerous other special support committees that provide support to the county program
- Shooting Sports: coordinator & discipline instructors

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## Adult Behavioral Expectations

- Basic expectations of 4-H Volunteers
- Signed annually
- Reaffirms your commitment to the program
- Includes a "Use of Vehicles for University Business" policy and personal liability waiver
- Authorizes annual review of the state and national sex offender registries for each volunteer
- References "Minors Safety and Child Abuse Reporting" Training

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## Range Plans

- Required for each range used in the program
- Responsibility of the County 4-H Youth Extension Educator, but usually developed with the assistance of the shooting sports coordinator and instructors
- Educator and Coordinator should keep a copy
- Used when a certificate of insurance is requested

Approval is required before a range is used.

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## Certificate of Insurance

- For proof of insurance *if* requested by property owner
- Must be signed and submitted by the County Extension Educator
- State coordinator must have range plans approved and on file

**Note**  
Purdue University extends coverage only to certified volunteers working in their capacity as 4-H leaders and 4-H members (grades 3-12).

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## Indiana State Fair 4-H Shooting Sports Exhibit Guidelines

- Counties may determine their own exhibit guidelines
- Exhibits advancing to the state fair must follow state fair guidelines
- Indiana State Fair
  - Exhibit guidelines, [www.four-h.purdue.edu/projects](http://www.four-h.purdue.edu/projects)
  - No firearms, bows, arrows, ammunition or parts of these items, are allowed on the State Fairgrounds.
  - No shoot/don't shoot posters

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## Exhibit Guidelines

- Grade: 3<sup>rd</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>**
  - 22" x 28" poster showing what you learned in the 4-H shooting sports project.
- Grade: 6<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>**
  - Poster, notebook, small project or model no larger than 18" x 18" x 36"
- Grade: 9<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>**
  - Poster, project or model (any size), or notebook

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## Exhibit Guidelines

**Independent Study:**

- Advanced topic - Learn all you can about an advanced shooting topic and present it on a poster and/or in a notebook.
- Mentoring - Exhibit a poster that shows how you mentored a younger 4-H member. Include your planning, the time you spent, the challenges and advantages of mentoring, and how the experience might be useful in your life.

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




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

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**Archery**

Name the types of bows. Label the parts of the archery equipment using the letters listed at the bottom of the page. Then find the words in the puzzle below.



Work with your Shooting Sports instructor to determine the project that is best for you. Your instructor will consider your interests, age, experience, and abilities to help you choose a project that is right for you.

**Project Ideas**

- String a bow.
- Fletch an arrow.
- Make a quiver.
- Make a bowstring.
- Make a finger tab or arm guard.
- Make a bow stringer.
- Make a target - traditional, creative, 3D, for various skill levels - using readily available items.
- Record your practice on video to analyze your technique.
- Record a hunt with a camera or video.
- Make posters of range rules, archery safety principles, or archery tackle with parts identified.
- Construct quiz boards that match parts with points indicated by letters, numbers, or other means.
- Develop a poster or demonstration to show the steps of good archery shooting.
- Make a ground quiver with a bow support for range use.
- Display a model or diagram of a compound bow, labeling all the functioning parts.
- Compare trajectories of several bows with equal draw weights but different designs. Present the results as graphs and discuss them in your notebook or give them to a younger youth. Sample graphs may be included.
- Build an item you have made for use with compound bows, for example a bow scale, string jig, compound bowstringer, or bow rack.
- Present an action demonstration on any of the ideas listed above.

**Games & Activities**

Shooting games and activities to learning fun. Ask your instructor if you do these. Older youth may be taught younger 4-Hers (with archery instructors to determine time to do this).

- Clout shooting.
- Flu flu shooting.
- Archery golf.
- Wind shooting.
- Card games (3 players) - 3.
- Tic Tac Toe.
- 10 an archery shoot.
- Field archery shoots.

- Liability and Insurance for Volunteers
- Starting a 4-H Shooting Sports Program

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## Insurance

- **Liability** for employees & volunteers working within the scope of their duties – Purdue
- **Accident/injury** for 4-H members and approved volunteers – 4-H; Special Activities
- **Equipment and property** – County responsibility
- **Auto** – Personal vehicle policy
- **Range** – Property owner, Purdue Certificate of Insurance

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## Reporting Accidents/Incidents

- Arrange for appropriate medical care
- Report accident or incident to 4-H Shooting Sports Coordinator and 4-H Extension Educator
- Assist in completion of Accident/Incident Report Form (RM27)

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## Health Forms

- Health forms should not be collected unless 4-H members are going on a trip
- Shooting Sports instructors may not collect health information – it is the parents' responsibility to let instructors know about possible issues
- You can invite parents to share any information that they think is important for you to know (e.g. food allergies & allergies to bee stings)
